

INMATE SERVICES

Inmate work opportunities: There are two (2) types of work opportunities available to individuals confined at BCCF. An individual may be selected for an institutional job assignment, which can be either inside or outside. Those inmates assigned to jobs which are outside of BCCF require a higher level of clearance, and must be approved by the Classification Committee, Deputy Warden, the Warden, and at times the Probation Department. In addition, BCCF operates a workforce program that provides work opportunities within the facility.

Barbering services: Barbering service is available on a scheduled basis.

Religious activities: The Chaplain is available to meet inmates' individual religious needs. A representative from other faiths may be contacted for inmates by the Chaplain, if requested.

Counseling: The Treatment Specialist is available to each housing unit for problem solving, to provide information about all programs at BCCF, and to complete all referrals to appropriate staff and programs (i.e. AA, NA, Educational and Work Programs. Correctional Officers also provide support and/or intervention. They are available to assist each inmate with any problems they may experience.

Commissary: This is a store within a correctional facility, that inmates may purchase items such as hygiene items, snacks, writing instruments and clothing. Commissary is available for inmates' purchases. You can send the inmate a money order to be put on their account for the purchase of commissary.
